


Getting the Big Picture

Are you ready for something big? The whole Bible gives you a big picture of what God is like. God wants you to know the big picture about Him. He loves you very much. He wants you to spend time with Him every day. That will help you know Him better.



This time with God is called a “quiet time.” You can think about God. You can read about God. You can talk to Him in prayer.



This book will help you with your quiet time. You will get the big picture about God. You will find out what He says in the Bible.



Choose a time to spend with God each day. It may be when you first get up. It may be just before you go to bed. There is a new story in this book for every day. After you read all the stories, go back and read them again!

This book is special. It has 100 Bible stories just for you! It is written so you can read it yourself. The pictures were drawn by children like you.



Are you ready to start? Every day you can learn more of God's big picture. Here is what to do. You can start with story number one.



- **Talk to God.** Ask Him to help you learn about Him.



- **Read the story.** Each story is from God's Word. You can find it in your own Bible. Read the story carefully. Think about what it says. The stories will help you know how to live God's way.



- **Talk to God again.** The part called "You can pray" will help you get started.



- **Read "God's Word Says."** These words come right from God. They are written for you in the Bible. They will help you understand the story.



- **Read the "Let's Talk" questions.** Think about the answers. You can tell the answers to someone in your family if you want to.

Have fun learning more about God every day!



1. The Beginning



Have you ever wondered how the world started? How did the sun get in the sky? Where did the animals come from? The Bible tells you. It is called God's Word.

God has always lived. He created the heavens and Earth. God is most powerful of all! He made the heavens and the Earth from nothing! God made light so it would not always be dark. He made the sky.

God's Word Says:
"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."
Genesis 1:1

2. Creation Completed

What kinds of choices do you make every day? You decide to do right or wrong. Adam and Eve had to make choices too.

God said they could eat from any tree in the garden but one. If they ate that fruit, they would be punished. Satan is God's enemy. He lied to Eve about what God had said. She ate the fruit. She gave some to Adam. They disobeyed God.

God's Word Says:

“Christ [Jesus] died for our sins.”
1 Corinthians 15:3

That was the first sin. Sin is doing what God says is wrong. God must punish sin. Many bad things happened. Adam and Eve had to leave the garden. Some day their bodies would die.



Everyone since then has sinned. You have sinned. God promised to send someone to save people from sin. After many years God sent His perfect Son to Earth. His name was Jesus. He never sinned. Jesus was nailed to a cross. He died for your sin, He was punished for you. Then He came back to life.

Because Jesus died, you can be forgiven. You can trust that Jesus has taken your punishment. You will be saved from sin.




You Can Pray:

God's Word Says:
“Come, let us bow down in worship.”
Psalm 95:6

Who is God's enemy? It is Satan. He wants people to sin. Satan wanted Jesus to sin too.





14. Feeding the 5,000




Is it hard to share? You may not think you have much to share. But God can use even a little bit to help others!

What can you share? You can share a smile with a sad friend. You can share kind words with others. You can share your time to help someone with a problem. Let God use what you have to help others.


Jesus took the boy's lunch. He thanked God for it. The disciples fed all the people. Everyone had all they could eat. There was even food left over!

16. The Ten Lepers




Do you remember to say thank you? It is important to thank people for the nice things they do. It is even more important to thank God!



17. Jesus and the Children




Do you ever feel too young? There are some things you cannot do if you are little. Coming to Jesus is something you can do even if you are young.


Jesus took the children in His arms and blessed them.

18. Blind Bartimaeus




Have you ever praised someone? That means to say something good about him or her. God deserves your praise most of all!


God deserves to be praised. Every day He does wonderful things! He loves you. He takes care of you. He gives you everything you need. You can praise God for who He is and what He does.




20. Triumphal Entry


Judas was not faithful to Jesus. Later that night he brought Jesus’ enemies to Him. They arrested Jesus and took Him away.

25. Jesus Is Buried




Has someone you know died? You feel sad when someone close to you dies. Jesus' friends were very sad when He died.

Mary did not know the man was Jesus. Then He said her name. Mary was so surprised and happy! She ran back to tell the disciples, "Jesus is alive!"


Who can you tell that Jesus is alive? Tell your friends and family. They need to know Jesus died for their sins and came back to life.

28. Return to Heaven




Are you ever afraid to tell people about Jesus? There is someone who can give you courage to witness. Jesus' friends found out about Him.




What job did Jesus give His disciples before He went back to Heaven? He wanted them to tell others about Him!

Some missionaries work in their own countries. Others go to another country. They tell people about Jesus. Someday God may ask you to be a missionary. Are you willing to obey Him?


Telling people around the world about Jesus is a big job. You do not have to do it alone! Jesus said, “I am with you always.” He will help you.


